




Stop and Lock then Shop!

- ALWAYS **stop** for a moment, and take the time to **lock your vehicle**.
- DO NOT store valuables such as GPS devices, cell phones, MP3 players, cash, or credit cards, etc., in your vehicle.
- Be aware of your surroundings. Don't text or talk on the phone while walking through parking lots, stores, or shopping centers.
- Don't overload yourself with shopping bags. It makes you a target for theft.
- Make several trips to your car to store packages in the trunk or out of sight during your shopping spree. If your vehicle does not have a trunk, keep valuables out of sight.
- Park in well lit areas at night.
- Remember where you park, and have your keys ready when you leave the store or shopping mall.
