Electronics Recycling

Fees are charged to recycle the following items:

All televisions \$7 each

(These items require special handling due to the leaded glass and mercury they contain. Payment is accepted by cash or check.)

Items accepted at no charge include:

Computer systems (hard drive, CPU, monitor) computer accessories (cables, wires, keyboards, mice, speakers, etc.), printers, scanners and copiers, FAX machines, VCRs, camcorders, stereos, and microwave ovens.

We do not accept:

Compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs)
refrigerators, dehumidifiers, or air conditioners.
