Leaf Recycling

Mulching & composting your leaves nourishes your lawn and garden. The Virginia Cooperative Extension Service recommends placing your leaves through a shredder or mower to create mulch and compost that is good for weed control and soil amendment. Leaf Burning

Leaf Vacuum Services

Henrico County offers a leaf vacuuming services for \$30 per order during the following times:

- Nov. 13, 2017 – Dec. 30, 2017
- Feb. 26, 2018 - March 30, 2018

To be eligible for vacuum services, the leaf piles:

- Must be accessible from the road in front of your Henrico property
- Must not contain trash, sticks or debris as this prevents the leaves from being recycled.

Please note that we work hard to collect vacuum leaf orders in a timely manner. We cannot guarantee an exact timeframe for collection due to the large volume of orders placed and weather conditions that complicate collection efforts. Your patience is greatly appreciated!



Prevent Pollution

We kindly ask that **you place your leaves in an accessible location in front of your property** in order to prevent the degradation of water quality, flooding, traffic hazards, and untidiness of your neighborhood. **Please do not block traffic lanes, parking, roadside gutter pans, or drainage ditches.** County ordinances restrict the placement of leaves in these locations, as leaves can obstruct stormwater drainage, leading to degraded water quality and flooding. Leaves in our streams and waterways contribute to stormwater pollution, as they often contain dirt, debris, and pet waste. Please help keep your neighborhood neat and attractive by properly placing your bagged and loose leaves and promptly calling for leaf vacuum service.

Bagged Leaf Collection

From November 13 through February 4, Henrico crews will collect bagged leaves placed at curb for **FREE**.

Things to Know:

- Bagged-leaves should be on the curb or the edge of the road by **7:00 AM on Monday** of your collection week.
- Our crews will make **one pass** down each street to collect bagged leaves.
- Our employees **cannot** enter your property to remove bags.
- **Bags should only contain leaves;** no garbage or other debris.
- **No limit** on the number of bags you may put out.
- We frequently collect on weekends.
