The meeting was called to order by the Chairman at 7:03 p.m.

Mr. Donati commented that he hoped all had a joyous Christmas holiday and he wished all a happy new year.

Mr. Donati led the Board, staff, and public in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Dr. W. Fred Rose, Pastor, Tuckahoe Presbyterian Church, provided the invocation.

On motion of Mrs. O'Bannon, seconded by Mr. Thornton, the Board approved the minutes of the December 11, 2007 Regular and Special Meetings and November 29, 2007 Special Meeting.

MANAGER'S COMMENTS

On December 11, 2007, the Board of Supervisors authorized the third of seven sales of General Obligation bonds arising from the March 2005 Bond Referendum. The proceeds from this particular issuance of \$30.8 million will fund school facilities and fire stations. Prior to the actual sale of the bonds, the County's "Triple – Triple A" General Obligation Bond ratings were reaffirmed after a review by the nation's three independent bond rating agencies (Fitch, Moody's, and Standard and Poor's). Only 21 of 3,033 counties nationwide possess these ratings, which offer significant savings to the County's taxpayers and are one of the key components that are looked at by corporate entities when they consider where to locate their facilities. Mr. Hazelett congratulated John A. Vithoulkas in his new position as Director of Finance and his staff for all of their efforts towards making Henrico County better than 99.3 percent of the nation's counties.

Mr. Hazelett recognized several members of his family who were seated in the audience, including his wife, Shardale Hazelett; his sister, Rebecca Killinger; and his sister's husband, Brit Killinger.

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' COMMENTS

Mr. Thornton complimented the Department of Public Works for putting up a facility so citizens can continue using Wilkinson Road while its deteriorated pavement is being repaired.

Mr. Kaechele thanked Dr. Rose for being present and for his encouraging words during the invocation. He noted that Dr. Rose is a great asset to the community and to the members of Tuckahoe Presbyterian Church and has previously served on the County's Board of Social Services.

APPOINTMENTS/ORGANIZATIONAL ITEMS

Mr. Rapisarda assumed the Chair to conduct the election of the new Chairman of the Board of Supervisors. He called for nominations for the office of Chairman and Mr. Glover nominated Mr. Kaechele. Mr. Donati seconded the nomination. Mr. Rapisarda asked if there were any further nominations and hearing none declared that the nominations were closed.

1-08 Resolution – Election of Chairman

On motion of Mr. Glover, seconded by Mr. Donati, and by unanimous vote, the Board approved Agenda Item No. 1-08 – see attached Resolution.

Following his election as Chairman, Mr. Kaechele thanked the Board for the honor and privilege to serve as Chairman for 2008. He noted that the Board has the proud distinction of having served together for 12 years, a record for the Commonwealth of Virginia, and that the members have 88 years of collective experience to build on

during the next four years. Mr. Kaechele acknowledged and thanked Mr. Hazelett and his staff for their professionalism and leadership in making Henrico a well run, honest, highly respected, and first-class county. He cited this performance as a big factor in this Board's longevity record. Mr. Kaechele also thanked Mr. Donati for his service and performance in 2007 and for doing his usual great job.

Mr. Kaechele predicted a challenging year in 2008 with an uncertain economy, a state budget shortfall, declining assessments and revenue growth, and a tough budget. He stated that the Board is looking forward to working with the newly elected School Board, new Director of Finance, new Deputy County Manager for Community Development (Randall R. Silber), and the rest of the staff as County officials grow together as a team and make 2008 a positive and successful year.

Within the Board's numerous responsibilities, Mr. Kaechele pointed to two current County programs that he would like to see the Board highlight and promote for 2008 with follow up, recommended actions, and periodic reporting from the County Manager. These two areas are 1) reducing health care and insurance costs through increased emphasis on health maintenance, wellness incentives, and healthy eating and lifestyles that will include educational and promotional programs to inform and encourage employees and citizens to participate in enhancing their own personal lifestyles; and 2) increased emphasis and promotion of timely energy conservation and green initiatives, including the design and construction of a green school or other LEED certified building.

Mr. Kaechele recognized his daughter, Kathy Raouf, for her support and encouragement over the years. He thanked the County's citizen volunteers being appointed and reappointed to boards and commissions for their service and willingness to participate, and referred to them as a great asset to the County. Mr. Kaechele presented a gift to Mr. Donati on behalf of the Board.

After accepting the gift, Mr. Donati commented that it has been an honor serving the citizens of this County and serving in the role of Chairman on this prestigious Board. He alluded to the three goals he had in mind when he became Chairman last year dealing with seniors, enterprise zones, and transportation. Mr. Donati pointed out that the Board has worked with the Virginia General Assembly to give Henrico's seniors the highest real estate tax abatement possible in the Commonwealth, will be voting on an enhanced enterprise zone incentive package at an upcoming meeting, and is making some headway on transportation issues with the recent roadway improvements on Route 5 and in working with the General Assembly on changing the funding formula for Henrico. He also referred to the County's productive year with respect to historical places, including the opening of the Armour House, Clarke-Palmore House, and Henrico Theatre. Mr. Donati thanked the Board and County's professional staff for providing these services to Henrico citizens.

Mr. Donati noted that it has been a little bit of a bumpy road but that he is looking forward to 2008. He congratulated the members of the Board on their re-election and

thanked them for providing him with the opportunity to serve this prestigious County as Chairman.

Mr. Kaechele called for nominations for the office of Vice-Chairman and Mr. Thornton nominated Mrs. O'Bannon. Mr. Donati seconded the nomination. Mr. Kaechele asked if there were any further nominations and hearing none declared that the nominations were closed.

PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS

Ordinance - To Amend and Reordain Section 23-231 Titled "Authority of county manager," Section 23-232 Titled "Use of water during water emergency," Section 23-233 Titled "Notice of declaration of water emergency," and Section 23-234 Titled "Reserved" of the Code of the County of Henrico to Permit Mandatory Restrictions on the Use of Water From the County's Public Water System Under Certain Conditions and to Establish Penalties for Violations.

In response to a question from Mr. Glover, Director of Public Utilities Arthur D. Petrini advised that there were three triggers for declaration of a water emergency under this proposed ordinance – when the County Manager deems it appropriate due to low flow, when the City of Richmond declares a trigger, or when the Director of Public Utilities advises the County Manager that due to regulatory constraints the County has a trigger. In response to a question from Mr. Kaechele, Mr. Petrini clarified that the County restrictions were lifted on January 7. In response to a question from Mrs. O'Bannon, Mr. Petrini clarified that the river was currently running about 2,600 cubic feet per second (CFS) as opposed to about 1,100 CFS when the mandatory restrictions were initially imposed.

No one from the public spoke in opposition to this ordinance.

On motion of Mr. Donati, seconded by Mrs. O'Bannon, and by unanimous vote, the Board approved Agenda Item No. 25-08 – see attached Ordinance.

26-08 Ordinance - To Participate in the John Tyler Alcohol Safety Action Program.

In response to questions from Mr. Kaechele, Deputy County Manager for Community Services George T. Drumwright, Jr. pointed out that there is no cost of this program to the County, that funding comes from fees collected from those persons who participate in the program, that the County was already participating in the program, and that there were 857 referrals to the program during Fiscal Year 2006-07. In response to questions from Mrs. O'Bannon, General District Court Judge Archer L. Yeatts, III clarified that persons convicted of Driving under the Influence (DUI) are required by statute to be referred to an Alcohol Safety Action Program (ASAP) and that a person cannot get an unrestricted driver's license from the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) at any time in the future until they have completed the program. In response to a further question from Mrs. O'Bannon, Mr. Drumwright advised that the ordinance was now necessary because of changes in the State Code and because the County had never become a member of the John Tyler ASAP even though it had been participating in the program for a number of years. In response to another question from Mr. Kaechele, Mr. Drumwright clarified that the program had an office in Courthouse Commons across from the Henrico County Government Center as well as

an office in Chesterfield County. In response to an additional question from Mrs. O'Bannon, Judge Yeatts stated that once persons are referred to the ASAP there are steps they go through in that program in terms of evaluation and education. If it is determined that they are at a certain level of need, they are required to have treatment which they have to pay for and which is supervised by professional providers rather the employees of the John Tyler ASAP.

In response to a question from a citizen residing in the Tuckahoe District, Faye Ould, Mr. Drumwright clarified that there is no formal or informal relationship between John Tyler Community College and John Tyler ASAP.

No one from the public spoke in opposition to this ordinance.

1. That Section 23-231 is hereby amended and reordained as follows:

Sec. 23-231. Authority of county manager-Definitions.

During periods of water shortage, the county manager may declare water emergencies in any or all areas in which the county supplies water.

Assessment date: The date of the water bill on which a fine for violation of this ordinance is imposed.

Established landscaping: Landscaping plantings including, but not limited to, gardens, flowers, trees and shrubs existing in an area after such period of time as to accomplish an establishment and maintenance of growth.

Established lawns: Lawns existing in an area after such period of time as to accomplish an establishment and maintenance of growth.

Fountain: A water display where water is sprayed strictly for ornamental purposes.

Golf course: An irrigated and landscaped playing area made up of greens, tees, fairways, roughs and related areas used for the playing of golf.

<u>New landscaping:</u> Any landscaping planted in or transplanted to an area within such period of time as to accomplish a reasonable establishment and maintenance of growth.

New lawns: Lawns made up of sod or seeds planted in or transplanted to an area within such period of time as to accomplish a reasonable establishment and maintenance of growth. This does not include refurbishment of established lawns by means of aeration and seeding, dethatching and seeding, or power overseeding.

Person: Any individual, corporation, partnership, association, company, business, trust, joint venture or other legal entity.

Swimming pool: Any structure, basin, chamber, or tank including hot tubs, containing an artificial body of water for swimming, diving or recreational bathing and having a depth of two feet or more at any point.

2. That Section 23-232 is hereby amended and reordained as follows:

Sec. 23-232. Use of water during water emergency Mandatory public water use restrictions.

During declared water emergencies, it shall be a class 1 misdemeanor to use water supplied by the county to water or sprinkle lawns or gardens or to use water between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m., or such other period of time specified in the emergency declaration, for any purpose not essential to health.

The use of the public water system shall be limited as follows:

- a. Fountains. Water use is prohibited.
- b. Paved areas. Washing is prohibited except for health and safety requirements.
- c. Swimming pools. Filling and replenishing to maintain health and safety is permitted. New or repaired pools may be filled as needed to maintain their structural integrity. All other uses are prohibited.
- d. Vehicle washing. Non-commercial washing of vehicles is prohibited, except that construction, emergency or public transportation vehicles may be washed as needed to preserve their proper functioning and safe operation. Commercial vehicle washing businesses are permitted to operate under normal conditions.
- e. Established landscaping. Watering is limited to three days per week by address. Addresses ending in an odd number may water only on Tuesday, Thursday and Saturday. Addresses ending with an even number, or with no number, may water only on Wednesday, Friday and Sunday. No watering is allowed on Mondays. Bucket watering (five gallon maximum size) is permitted any time.
- f. Established lawns. Watering is prohibited. Bucket watering (five gallons maximum size) is permitted any time.
- g. New landscaping. Watering is permitted for the first 30 days after planting. Thereafter, the restriction for established landscaping shall apply.
- h. New lawns. Watering is permitted for the first 30 days after sodding or seeding.

 Thereafter, the restriction for established lawns shall apply. New lawns do not include refurbishment of established lawns by means of aeration and seeding, dethatching and seeding, or power overseeding.
- i. Restaurants. Water shall be served to customers only upon request.
- j. Golf courses. Watering is prohibited from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., except for the watering of greens or watering by hand-held hoses that are one inch or smaller in diameter.
- k. All other businesses. Water use is limited to uses essential for business use and human hygiene.
- l. Athletic fields. Athletic fields may be watered only between 8:00 p.m. and 10:00 a.m. and only at a rate not exceeding a total of one inch during any ten-day period.

3. That Section 23-233 is hereby amended and reordained as follows:

Sec. 23-233. Notice of declaration of water emergency When restrictions go into effect; notice.

To declare a water emergency, the county manager shall place a notice in the Richmond Times-Dispatch and shall post a written declaration of emergency at the front door of the county courthouse and at three prominent places in the areas for which a water emergency is being declared.

- (a) The water use restrictions set forth in this ordinance shall take effect when any one or more of the following conditions occurs:
 - 1. The Director of Public Utilities for the City or his designee advises the Director of Public Utilities for the County in writing that the City is invoking mandatory water use restrictions; or
 - 2. The Director of Public Utilities for the County or his designee advises the County Manager in writing that the James River flow levels meet the water treatment plant's DEQ intake permit requirements for mandatory water conservation; or
 - 3. The County Manager declares in writing the need for mandatory water conservation for the County.
- (b) The water use restrictions shall end when the notice that triggered them is superseded by a notice indicating the reason for the restrictions no longer exists.
- (c) Notice of these public water use restrictions shall be published in the Richmond Times-Dispatch for a period of one day per week each week during which the restrictions are in effect.
- 4. That Section 23-234 is hereby amended and reordained as follows:

- (a) Any person who uses water, or allows or causes the use of water, in violation of any provision of this ordinance after publication of notice pursuant to Section 23-233(c) shall be subject to the following penalties:
 - 1. For the first offense, violators shall receive a written warning delivered in person or posted by a representative of the Henrico County Department of Public Utilities.

- 2. For the second offense, violators shall be fined \$50.00, the fine to be imposed on the violator's next water bill.
- 3. For the third and each subsequent offense, violators shall be fined \$100.00 for each offense, the fine to be imposed on the violator's next water bill.
- 4. Each violation by a person shall be counted as a separate violation by that person, irrespective of the location at which the violation occurs.
- (b) Persons who have been assessed a penalty shall have the right to challenge the assessment by providing a written notice to the Director of Public Utilities within 10 days of the assessment date. The Director shall determine whether the penalty was properly assessed and notify the complaining person in writing of his determination. Should the Director determine that the penalty was properly assessed, the person may appeal that determination by providing written notice to the County Manager within 10 days of receiving the notice of determination. The County Manager or his designee shall determine whether the penalty was properly assessed and notify the complaining person in writing of his determination.
- (c) The Director of Public Utilities may waive the penalty if he determines that the violation occurred due to no fault of the person.
- 5. That this Ordinance shall supersede the emergency water restrictions ordinance adopted on November 13, 2007 and shall be in full force and effect on and after its passage as provided by law.

WHEREAS, Henrico County desires to become a participating jurisdiction in the John Tyler ASAP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Henrico County, Virginia (the "Board") that:

- 1. Henrico County hereby agrees to become a participating jurisdiction in the John Tyler ASAP;
- 2. The operating budget of the John Tyler ASAP shall be prepared by its Executive Director and submitted for approval to the John Tyler ASAP Board of Directors for each fiscal year and will include client fees and other available funds as deemed appropriate by the Board of Directors, but neither the operating budget nor any future capital requests will include costs, fees or funding by Henrico County;
- 3. An annual report shall be prepared under the supervision of the John Tyler ASAP Board of Directors and presented to the Board indicating the activities of the John Tyler ASAP as related to the County;
- 4. The County's agreement to participate in the John Tyler ASAP shall remain in effect for three years commencing immediately and thereafter shall automatically renew from year to year;
- 5. The County may withdraw from participation in the John Tyler ASAP at any time by official action of the Board;
- 6. Under the Agreement to Participate, title to all property acquired by the John Tyler ASAP shall be vested with the John Tyler ASAP so long as two or more localities continue to participate in its operation. In the event that all localities withdraw from the operation of the John Tyler ASAP or in the event that only one locality continues to participate in the operation of John Tyler ASAP, all property owned by John Tyler ASAP shall be sold at public auction and the proceeds of such sale shall be apportioned and be paid to those localities which have participated in the operation of the John Tyler ASAP from 1979 until its dissolution, and each locality shall be paid an equal percentage of the proceeds; and
