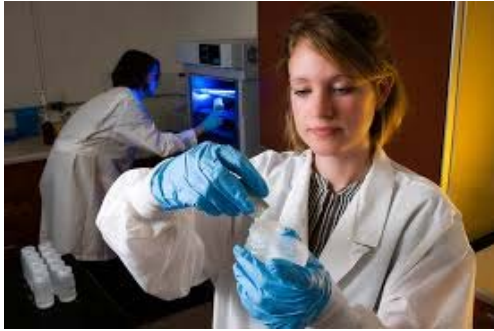


WELL WATER TESTING CLINIC
