FEE TO RECYCLE THE FOLLOWING:

\$23 fee for TVs less than 27"

***\$30 fee for TVs larger than 27"**

These items require special handling due to the leaded glass and mercury they contain.

***Payment is accepted by cash or check only.**

ITEMS ACCEPTED AT NO CHARGE:

Computer systems (hard drive, CPU, monitor); printers; computer accessories (cables, wires, keyboards, mice, speakers, etc.); copiers; scanners; FAX machines; VCRs; camcorders; stereos; and microwave ovens.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED:

Compact fluorescent light bulbs (CFLs); refrigerators; dehumidifiers; and AC units.

*** DOCUMENT SHREDDING LIMITATIONS:**

Free document shredding for personal documents only, limited to the following quantities and materials:

2 boxes (10"x13"x18") full

-OR-

3 paper grocery bags full**

****DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS to bring shredding materials; paper bags or boxes only!**

**NO recyclable paper items accepted.
Personal documents ONLY.**

NOTE: Do Not place electronic items in the bags or boxes with your shredding items. This will jam machines. Electronics recycling is separate from the document shredding.

ALL DOCUMENTS/ITEMS FOR RECYCLE/SHREDDING SHOULD BE PLACED IN A LOCATION ACCESSIBLE BY ON SITE STAFF, CITIZEN WILL NOT GET OUT OF THEIR CAR
