## OFF-DUTY POLICE ASSIGNMENTS ESTABLISHED RATES OF PAY

Effective January 01, 2023

Below are the current rates of pay for Sworn Henrico County Police Division Members performing off-duty assignments:

Position Title	Hourly Rate	Required minimum of 3 hours per assignment
Police Officer	\$40.00	\$120.00
Police Sergeant	\$50.00	\$150.00
Police Lieutenant and above	\$60.00	\$180.00

Whenever a request is made for the assignment of more than three officers, the fourth officer assigned shall be a supervisor and paid at the Sergeant's off-duty rate, regardless of rank. For larger events that require an Operations Plan and After-Action Report, one additional hour will be invoiced for the lead officer or supervisor.

**PERMITTED EVENTS:** To ensure we are able to staff all special events that require a permit within Henrico County, the pay rate for each officer required for these events will be **\$60/hour**, regardless of rank.

**HOLIDAY PAY:** All rates will have a \$20/hour increase for any assignment that falls on the below listed County holidays and special event dates. These rates will be effective from 0001-0000 on each listed date.
