Police Seek Suspects in Catalytic Converter Theft

(Henrico County, Va.) - On Saturday, February 26, 2022, two suspects in a white Dodge Challenger with what appears to be blue stripes stole catalytic converters from two businesses during daylight hours in the 1900 block of New Market Road, near S. Laburnum Avenue in eastern Henrico County. This Detectives obtained surveillance footage that captured a suspect and the vehicle involved. Detectives point out the noticeable dent on the passenger side door of the Challenger and the distinctive stripe pattern and coloring.
