School bus rear-ended along Staples Mill Road

(Henrico County, Va.) – On Friday, April 29, 2022, around 7:28 am, Henrico Police responded to the report of a crash involving a school bus rear-ended by a van, in the eastbound lanes of Staples Mill Road (Rt. 33), near Townhouse Road. The right lane was closed while police and first responders assessed the crash.

The investigation revealed a van rear-ended the school bus, causing significant damage to the van, and was towed from the scene, and the bus remained drivable. Students were on board the school bus, but none were transported by EMS.

Police concluded the investigation and charged the adult female driver of the van with 1) following too closely, 2) improper registration, and 3) failure to have insurance.

Henrico Police reminds all drivers to remain alert, avoid distractions, and ensure their vehicle is properly registered.
