Henrico Police seek any tips related to juvenile homicide

Updated Release 2:

(Henrico County, Va.) – Henrico County Police have charged a juvenile in connection to yesterday's homicide. The juvenile has been charged on petitions with attempted robbery and murder. The juvenile is in custody at the Henrico Juvenile Detention Home.

Updated Release 1:

(Henrico County, Va.) - Henrico County Police worked into the overnight hours investigating a homicide involving a juvenile teen. While the juvenile's next-of-kin has been notified, law enforcement cannot identify juvenile victims.

Detectives are seeking any information from members of our Glenwood Farms community regarding the initial shooting.

The shooting occurred sometime before 4 pm, and the driver was transporting the victim to a nearby hospital, stopped, and summoned assistance from a Virginia State Police Trooper just after 4 o'clock. The Trooper and VDOT Safety Service Patrol rendered aid until the victim could be transported to the hospital, where the juvenile succumbed to injuries sustained.

(Henrico County, Va.) – On Thursday, May 19, 2022, just after 4 pm, a Virginia State Trooper was assisting a disabled motorist along I-64 westbound on the Shockoe Valley bridge, near the 191 mile-marker. While with the motorist, a second vehicle pulled up, and the driver requested assistance from the trooper for a passenger with apparent wounds from a shooting.

The Trooper and the VDOT Safety Service Patrol (SSP) rendered aid to the victim while emergency crews responded to the scene. In addition, the victim was transported to the hospital with critical injuries.

Henrico Police are in the early stages of the shooting investigation, working on learning what transpired before 4 pm today, the exact location, and the identity of those involved. Additional details will be forthcoming as they become available.

Traffic along I-64 westbound was all merged to a single left lane while police worked to collect evidence and ultimately clear the scene promptly. All lanes have reopened.

Detectives want to hear from those in the community with information about this incident, spanning from eastern Henrico County to the city-county line.
