Henrico Man Arrested After Reported Firearm Violation

(Henrico County, Va.) – On Sunday, July 31, 2022, Henrico Police responded to the 600 block of N. Laburnum Avenue just before 10:30 am for calls to 9-1-1 about a man outside shooting a gun in a heavily populated apartment community. Officers arrived, working to secure the area and protect area residents.

Just after 11:00 am, there were additional reports of gunfire by the man, which prompted Henrico Police to discharge their firearm. Police negotiated with the man until 1:15 pm when police were able to take him into custody safely after he exited the apartment on his own and began to run across the complex.

Terrance Antonio Brawner, 35, of Henrico County, was arrested and charged with attempted malicious wounding, use of a firearm in the commission of the attempted malicious wounding, maliciously discharging a firearm within an occupied dwelling, and felony vandalism. Brawner is being held without bond at the Henrico County Sheriff's Office.

The Officer-Involved Investigations Team investigates any firearm discharge by a Police Division member. The officers involved are on paid administrative assignments pending a complete and thorough investigation. "Fortunately, there were no injuries to anyone involved and only property damage sustained during the incident," says Lieutenant Matt Pecka.
