### Battlefield Park Road Homicide Arrests

#### UPDATE 1:

**(Henrico County, Va.)** – Henrico Police has arrested and charged three people in connection to the January 5 homicide off Battlefield Park Road.

During the investigation, detectives identified **Daquan Omar Wilson, 18, of Henrico, Kesean Nicolas Kent-Powell, 19, of Sandston** and a **male juvenile (16 years old)**, as suspects in this case. All three males face the following charges:

- **Daquan Wilson**
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Murder
  - Conspiracy to Commit Robbery
- **Kesean Kent-Powell**
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Murder
  - Conspiracy to Commit Robbery
- **Male Juvenile**
  - 2<sup>nd</sup> Degree Murder
  - Conspiracy to Commit Robbery

#### January 8 Release:
