
Arrests Made in Lakeside Avenue Homicide | Third Suspect at Large

(Henrico County, Va.) – Henrico Police is searching for a third suspect in connection to last month's Lakeside Avenue homicide.

On Monday, March 4, 2024, Henrico Police took two adults into custody on charges of 2nd degree murder and use of a firearm in the commission of a felony. These individuals are:

- Jaiden Akiva-Nadir Fowlkes, 18, of Henrico
- Diamond Chrishell Henley, 21, of Henrico

Detectives within the Henrico County Police Division continue to search for a third suspect, **Travis Lamar Paige, Jr., 22**, who is wanted on warrants of 2nd degree murder and use of a firearm in the commission of a felony. Mr. Paige is described as a black male, with brown eyes and black hair (which may be braided), 5'10" and weighs approximately 140 lbs. (*Please see picture below*)

On February 26, 2024, **Aidan Christopher Cameron, 18, of Henrico,** was found in a yard behind an apartment building in the 1600 block of Lakeside Avenue with apparent gunshot wounds. He was transported to an area hospital where he succumbed to his injuries.

(Henrico County, Va.) – Henrico Police is investigating a homicide that occurred overnight in the 1600 block of Lakeside Avenue.

On Monday, February 26, 2024, at approximately 12:06 a.m., Henrico Police responded to the 1600 block of Lakeside Avenue for a shooting. Once on scene, officers located an adult male with apparent gunshot wounds and began life-saving measures. He was transported to an area hospital, where he succumbed to his injuries this morning.

Currently, detectives are working on learning what transpired and informing the legal next-of-kin.
