Henrico Police Investigates Fatal Brook Road Pedestrian Crash

UPDATE 1

(Henrico County, Va.) – Henrico Police continues to investigate a deadly auto vs pedestrian crash that occurred on Brook Road.

On Saturday, March 16, 2024, at approximately 10:03 p.m., Henrico Police responded to the 5200 block of Brook Road for a reported traffic crash involving a pedestrian. Once on scene, officers located an adult female in the roadway with obvious signs of trauma. She was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Henrico Police has identified the victim as **Lolita Brumfield, 52, of Henrico**.

The preliminary investigation shows Ms. Brumfield attempted to cross the southbound lanes of Brook Road when she was struck by a Nissan Pathfinder. The driver involved in the crash remained on the scene. Non-reflective clothing and poor lighting in the area appear to be contributing factors in this crash.

(Henrico County, Va.) – On 03/16/2024 around 10:03 pm, Henrico officers responded to a report of a pedestrian struck in the roadway at Brook Rd. at Bentley St. An adult female was found lying in the middle of southbound Brook Rd. The female was declared deceased at the scene. The driver of the vehicle that struck the female was on scene when officers arrived. There were no signs of impairment on the driver upon initial investigation. Henrico's Crash Team is currently investigating.
