Henrico Police Investigate Fatal Motorcycle Crash Along W. Broad Street

(Henrico County, Va.) – Henrico Police continues to investigate a single-vehicle crash involving a motorcycle at the intersection of W. Broad Street and Bishop Road.

On April 8, 2024, at approximately 2:04 p.m., Henrico Police responded to the 4900 block of W. Broad Street near Willow Lawn for a reported motorcycle crash. The driver of the motorcycle, who was transported to an area hospital with life-threatening injuries, succumbed to his injuries sustained from the crash. The victim has been identified as **Keyshawn Diming, 25, of Cumberland, VA.**

The preliminary investigation indicates Mr. Diming was traveling westbound on W. Broad Street at a high rate of speed when he lost control of the motorcycle attempting to avoid other traffic. While speed and reckless driving are believed to be factors in this crash, investigators continue to gather evidence to better understand this incident.
