Adult leaders will...

- Abide by all rules, policies and procedures of the 4-H Center, as well as other rules outlined by 4-H agents and staff.
- Support teen counselors in the supervision of 9- to 13-year-old campers, both in cabins and during all activities at 4-H Camp.
- Provide for the safety and well being of each camp participant at all times.
- Help settle down and account for campers at lights-out.
- Immediately inform an Extension agent of any problems and concerns.
- Assist with camp activities, as requested by the camp director.
Examples may include helping staff with classes, helping campers find their classes, escorting campers to the clinic, helping to prepare for special programs, assisting campers with conflict resolution, etc.
- Show a positive attitude and be a role model for teen counselors and campers.
- Be patient, caring, responsible, and adaptable in dealing with people and situations at camp.
- Provide motivation and encouragement for all campers, especially those Who have trouble adjusting to camp.
