


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Woodman Road Roundabout project will result in the conversion of the existing intersection into a roundabout intersection and includes 0.30 miles of improvements to existing Greenwood Road. Additionally, Winfrey Road will be realigned to connect with existing Old Greenwood Road.

A single-lane roundabout will be constructed with this project and will connect to the proposed Woodman Road Extension.

The roundabout intersection was determined to be the best option based on several criteria including traffic operations, safety, property impacts and costs. Because roundabout intersections are designed to operate at lower travel speeds, they are inherently safer than signalized intersections.

Total Cost: **\$4,000,000**

This project will be funded through a combination of state (VDOT's Revenue-Sharing Program) and local funds.

Environmental Review

The County has hired Clark Nexsen to review the social, economic and environmental impacts of the project on the local community and the surrounding area. The project is being coordinated with the appropriate federal, state, and local agencies. As a result of this review, a determination will be made concerning the construction impacts of the project. We anticipate this will result in a finding of no significant impact.

During construction, all reasonable efforts will be made to protect the environment with respect to dust control, siltation and erosion. Construction will conform to Henrico County specifications and special provisions and the Virginia Department of Soil and Water Conservation regulations.

Property owners will be informed of the exact location of any needed easements and/or right-of-way during the acquisition process and prior to construction.

General information about right-of-way and/or easement acquisition can be discussed with Henrico County's Real Property representative attending this Citizen Information Meeting.

Get Involved

The public comment period will close on May 19, 2018 following this Citizen Information Meeting. Henrico County representatives will review and evaluate any information received as a result of the Citizen Information Meeting.

Right-of-way and easement acquisition is expected to begin this summer and construction is anticipated to begin in early 2019.

Project Overview



Existing Woodman Road and Greenwood Road Intersection.

Anticipated Cost – Approximately \$4,000,000

Purpose – To improve connectivity and traffic operations.

From – Existing Woodman Road

To – Greenwood Road

Total length – 0.30 miles (Greenwood Road)

Improvements – Intersection conversion to a roundabout with widening and improvements on Greenwood Road and a north leg connection to Woodman Road Extension. Improvements include curb and gutter, sidewalks and accommodations for a future shared-use path.
