The BGC Men's Tournament League is designed for competition in a friendly environment and open to golfers of all ability. Membership will include entry into 5 tournaments, to be played one Saturday a month at 8:30 a.m. (modified start). There will also be a 2 -day Club Championship (Sat & Sun) event in September.

- White tees for ages 59 and under, Gold tees for ages 60 and over
- Players are asked to check in by 8:00 a.m., with announcements starting at 8:15 a.m.
- Players are responsible for paying golf fees per round (\$44.00).
- Players will not be allowed to choose who they play with in tournaments.
- Members must have an established Handicap to play in association events. All play will be based on current handicap.
- A sign-up sheet will be posted in the Golf Shop for all tournaments. Registration is due by 6:00 p.m. the Thursday prior to tournament date.
- USGA Rules govern all play, except where tournament format or local rules apply.
- Prizes are awarded per event in the value of gift certificates that can be used in the Golf Shop for merchandise and or green/cart fees. All money collected in Association dues will be used to pay out for the prize fund each week and VSGA Handicap Fees.
- Players must have played in at least 2 tournaments to be eligible for club championship play.

#### **Local Rules**

- Participation numbers will determine the "game of the day" and payouts.
- Player may lift, clean, and place his ball within one club length no closer to hole in his own fairway. Place rakes inside bunkers.
- Red stakes denote lateral hazards and yellow stakes denote water hazards.
- Stones in bunkers are considered movable obstructions.
- An embedded ball anywhere through the green may be lifted, cleaned, and dropped as near as possible to where it lay, but no closer to the hole.
- If player thinks his shot may be lost or may have entered a hazard, he may play a provisional from the spot in order to expedite play until the position of his original shot has been determined.
- There may be times when the course conditions dictate preferred lies through the green. A local rule will be deemed on such days.
- Rangefinders that only measure distance may be used during competition.
