- Use only a gel pen to write out your checks. Other pens contain dyes and inks that can be "washed" away. Thieves often use this method called "check washing" to reuse checks stolen from victims.
- Never "pre sign" your blank checks. Write checks only as you need them.
- Fill in the entire payee line and amount line. If the payee's name or amount does not take up the entire line, draw a horizontal line to take up the blank space.
