

Certification of Asbestos Inspection

I hereby certify that the affected portions of the building have been inspected for the presence of asbestos by an individual licensed to perform such inspections pursuant to § 54.1-503 (Code of Virginia) and that no asbestos-containing materials were found or that appropriate response actions will be undertaken in accordance with the requirements of the Clean Air Act National Emission Standard for the Hazardous Air Pollutant (NESHAPS) (40 CFR 61, Subpart M), and the asbestos worker protection requirements established by OSHA for construction workers (29 CFR 1926.1101).

Where asbestos response actions are taken, I also certify that no asbestos abatement area will be reoccupied until all response actions have been completed and final air monitoring clearances have been measured and approved.

Exemption: The asbestos inspection requirement does not apply if the Permit for the initial construction of the building was issued after January 1, 1985, or to single-family dwellings or residential housing with four or fewer units unless the renovation or demolition of such buildings is for commercial or public development purposes. The requirement also does not apply if the combined amount of regulated asbestos-containing material involved in the renovation or demolition is less than 260 linear feet on pipes, or less than 160 square feet on other facility components, or less than thirty-five cubic feet of facility components where the length or area cannot be measured.

If exempt, check reason:

_____ The Permit for the initial construction of the building was issued after January 1, 1985.

_____ The building is a single-family dwelling*

_____ The building is residential housing consisting of four or fewer dwelling units*

____ The combined asbestos-containing material is less than 260 linear feet on pipes, less than 160 square feet on other facility components, or less than 35 cubic feet off facility components where the length or area cannot be measured.

The project consists only of repair or replacement of roofing, floor-covering, or siding. The affected materials are assumed to contain friable asbestos. The asbestos installation, removal, or encapsulation will be accomplished by a licensed asbestos contractor.

*Unless the renovation or demolition is for commercial or public development purposes.
