Community Cleanup Program

The Community Cleanup program has been suspended until further notice.

Due to the emergency declaration relating to COVID-19, we ask for the public's understanding as we have made the difficult decision to suspend the Community Cleanup program and other similar programs and services for the foreseeable future. We made this decision for the safety of our citizens, employees, and contractors. We understand that the Community Cleanup program is viewed as a vital resource for those who may not have the means to discard of bulky waste items. When the state of emergency has ended, staff will evaluate all available resources to determine if, and when, the program can resume.

It is the responsibility of residents to remove all items placed at the curb or road's edge for pickup. Code Compliance Inspectors will proactively contact residents and property owners regarding debris placed along the right-of-way. Failure to remove discarded items may result in a "Notice of Violation" and contractor abatement at the property owner's expense.

Public Utilities & Bulky Waste

Public Utilities may be operating with limited public services. Please **<u>DO NOT</u>** place items at the road's edge for pickup until you have confirmed a bulky waste order for your residence.
