Did you know that, when you call the police to report crime, you do not have to give your name or be seen by the responding officer?

When calling the police, it is important to give as much information as possible, such as:

- What is the location of the incident?
- How many people are involved?
- Are there weapons involved?
- Description of parties involved, to include sex, race, height, weight, color and style of clothing
- Which way did the subjects travel? Are they on foot or in a car? If they are in a car, try to provide the make, color and license plate.
