

# Sea Life Shark Hat

**Time Required:** 15-20 minutes

**Prep Required:** None

**Space (s) Needed:** Indoors

## Materials:

Paper-Blue (3 sheets)

Black (1 sheet)

White (1 sheet)

Marker

Glue

Stapler

Scissors

## Instructions:

1. Cut one sheet of blue paper longways into two equal strips.
2. Staple the two strips together to make one really long strip that fits around your head. This is the headband.
3. Cut second blue piece of paper into a large  $\frac{1}{2}$  oval shape. This will be the shark head.
4. Cut black piece of paper into  $\frac{1}{2}$  oval shape smaller than the blue  $\frac{1}{2}$  oval shape. This will be the shark mouth.
5. Glue the black mouth to the blue face.
6. Cut white paper into many small triangles that will be the teeth.
7. Glue white triangles around the edge of the black mouth.
8. Use marker to draw eyes.
9. Glue and/or staple the shark face to the headband. Staple the smooth side of the staple to the inside of the hat.
10. Let dry.
11. Staple the headband to fit your head.
12. Wear your shark hat proudly and pretend to rule the waters!

## Variations:
