#### Update of absentee voting for Special Election- Mr. Coakley

Absentee totals thus far for the 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District Special Election:

- Western Government Center- 567 voters
- Eastern Government Center- 1.051 voters
- Absentee mailed ballots (permanent voters)- 6,000.
- Voted ballots returned for processing- 2,404.
- Ballots received from the drop boxes:
  - 1. Western office- 148
  - 2. Eastern office- 145
  - 3. Varina Library-17
  - 4. Tuckahoe-1
  - 5. Deep Run- 0

Next Monday, the Varina Library location will open for in-person Absentee Voting. The dates are Monday, February 13<sup>th</sup> thru Saturday, February 18<sup>th</sup>.

The next two Saturdays: February 11<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> the Western & Eastern office will be opened from 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. for in-person Absentee Voting.
