### **Glenwood Farms' residents learn about county services, receive meals**

To help residents of Glenwood Farms understand available services, Henrico County Building Inspections hosted an educational tenant event at Fire Station 7 on Monday. Henrico County Community Revitalization, Division of Fire Care Team, Henrico Police Division, Department of Social Services and Community Affairs, along with Feed More and the Henrico Community Food Bank, partnered to provide resources, information and non-perishable food bags to 63 attendees.

With the help of community donations and volunteers, the two-day drive at the Eastern Henrico Recreation Center helped collect 6,160 pounds of food to support the identified families over the winter break. The Saturday distribution served 420 people.

## Henrico launches more road, trail, sidewalk projects with funds from CVTA



For years, Henrico County's transportation needs have exceeded its available funding. As a result, major projects – like building the Fall Line Trail, Lambert Way or the Magellan Parkway extension over Interstate 95 – have often had to wait years to proceed.

The same dynamic has snared smaller initiatives – such as building sidewalks along Raintree and Causeway drives, a trail along Messer Road or upgrading the intersection of Darbytown and Turner roads.

But Henrico is now able to advance each of those [projects](#) – and more – thanks to a new funding stream provided through the Central Virginia Transportation Authority (CVTA).

## Board of Supervisors approves county reapportionment plan

At a special meeting Dec. 16, the Henrico County Board of Supervisors approved a plan that makes minor shifts to the [boundaries](#) of Henrico's five magisterial districts.
