
Henrico County staff will address all questions and concerns raised as a result of this meeting.


## Project Description

This project consists of 1 mile of a 12-ft wide multi-use trail connecting Springfield Road to Francistown Road. Approximately 0.6 mile will be off-road accommodations and 0.4 mile on-road accommodations. Construction will include a pedestrian bridge over the Meredith Branch tributary. The trail will follow the existing Nuckols Road right of way alignment.

The County intends on applying for a federal Transportation Alternatives (TA) grant to fund the construction of the trail and welcomes comments from the community on this proposed trail.

## Environmental Review

Henrico County will review the social, economic, and environmental impacts of the proposed project on the local community and surrounding area. During construction, all reasonable efforts will be made to protect the environment with respect to dust control, siltation and erosion.

Construction will conform to all County, state, and federal standards and regulations with respect to protecting the environment.

## Right-of-Way/Easements

This proposed trail will be constructed primarily within existing county right-of-way. As the design is further developed, additional easements and right of way may be required beyond what is shown in the preliminary plans. Property owners will be informed of the exact location of the easements during the right-of-way acquisition process and prior to construction.

### Location:

From Springfield Road to Francistown Road

**Length:** 1 mile (approximate)

### Purpose:

To provide a safe and accessible trail to be used for commuting and recreational activities. The trail is intended for pedestrians, cyclists, and other forms of non-motorized transportation.

**Anticipated Cost:** \$2.6 Million

Right of Way Acquisition:	Summer 2022
Begin Construction:	Summer 2023
Project Completion:	Fall 2023
