Welcome to the County of Henrico public information meeting on the proposed Shady Grove Road and Old Nuckols Road Safety & Mobility Improvements project. The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for citizens or organizations to provide comments on the proposed project. The County wants all members of the community to have the opportunity to participate in public involvement on projects affecting them. County representatives are present to discuss the project and answer your questions.

Project Description

The Shady Grove Road and Old Nuckols Road Safety & Mobility Improvements project entails 1.25 miles of improvements to Shady Grove Road, Old Nuckols Road and Wyndham Forest Drive. The corridor includes Shady Grove Road from Olde Covington Way to Old Nuckols Road, Old Nuckols Road from Shady Grove Road to Nuckols Road, and Wyndham Forest Drive from Nuckols Road to Lemoore Drive. Proposed changes include:

Shady Grove Road:

- Two travel lanes & one center turn lane
- Two-way protected bike lane
- Shared Use Path from Olde Covington Way to Nuckols Road

Old Nuckols Road:

- Two travel lanes & one center turn lane
- Buffered Bike Lanes

Shady Grove Road and Old Nuckols Road intersection:

- Mini roundabout
- Shared use path connecting buffered bike lanes to two-way protected bike lane
- Pedestrian access improvements

Nuckols Road and Old Nuckols Road/ Wyndham Forest Drive Intersection:

- Median removal
- Traffic signalization upgrades
- Pedestrian access improvements

Wyndham Forest Drive:

- Two travel lanes
- Bike lanes

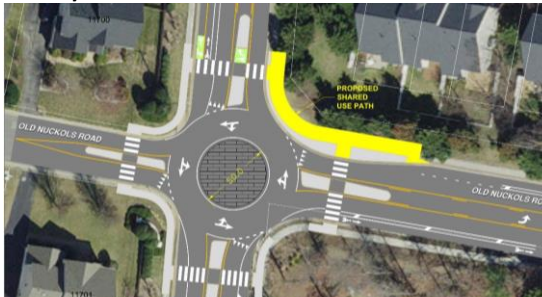

Project Overview

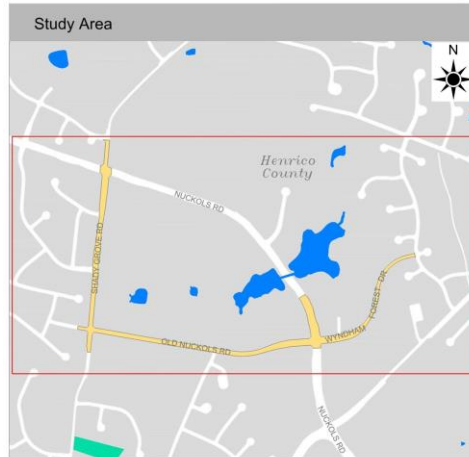
Location: Shady Grove Road from Olde Covington Way to Old Nuckols Road, and Old Nuckols Road/Wyndham Forest Drive from Shady Grove to Lemoore Drive.

Length: 1.25 miles

Purpose: To improve safety and mobility along Shady Grove Road, Old Nuckols Road, and Wyndham Forest Drive for motorists, while accommodating the needs of pedestrians and cyclists. The project is anticipated to include roadway, traffic signal, signing and marking improvements within the existing right-of-way, as well as improvements requiring right-of-way acquisition such as the roundabout, shared use path, and traffic signal improvements.

Anticipated Total Cost: \$2 million

Anticipated Schedule: The design of the project is underway and anticipated to be completed during the summer of 2023. Right-of-way acquisition is anticipated to begin during the fall of 2023. Construction is anticipated to begin during the spring/summer 2024.



Right of Way

Given the preliminary nature of the project at this time, displays at this meeting do not show the extent of right of way that may be needed. As the design is further developed, easements and right of way may be required. Property owners will be informed of the exact location of the easements during the right of way acquisition process and prior to construction.

Environmental Review

As the design develops, the County will review the environmental impacts of the project. As a result of this review, a determination will be made concerning the construction impacts of the project. During construction, all reasonable efforts will be made to protect the environment with respect to dust control, siltation, and erosion. Construction will conform to the County's specifications and special provisions and the Virginia Department of Soil and Water Conservation regulations.
