

Pavement Markings

Standard

The developer of subdivisions, plans of development, and roadway projects is responsible for the installation of pavement markings for the proposed road improvements, whether the road is public or private. The developer is also responsible for any necessary pavement marking changes, including eradication, to existing conditions as a result of his project. Any existing pavement markings disturbed during construction shall be replaced by the developer. If one line of a double yellow centerline is disturbed, both lines shall be reinstalled.

The pavement marking material used for new installations shall be Thermoplastic and shall have a minimum thickness of 90 mil.

All pavement markings shall be in accordance with the latest edition of the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD).

Installation shall be in accordance with VDOT specifications.

Applicability of the Standard

This standard applies to all types of development, including residential subdivisions, PODs, and CIPs.
