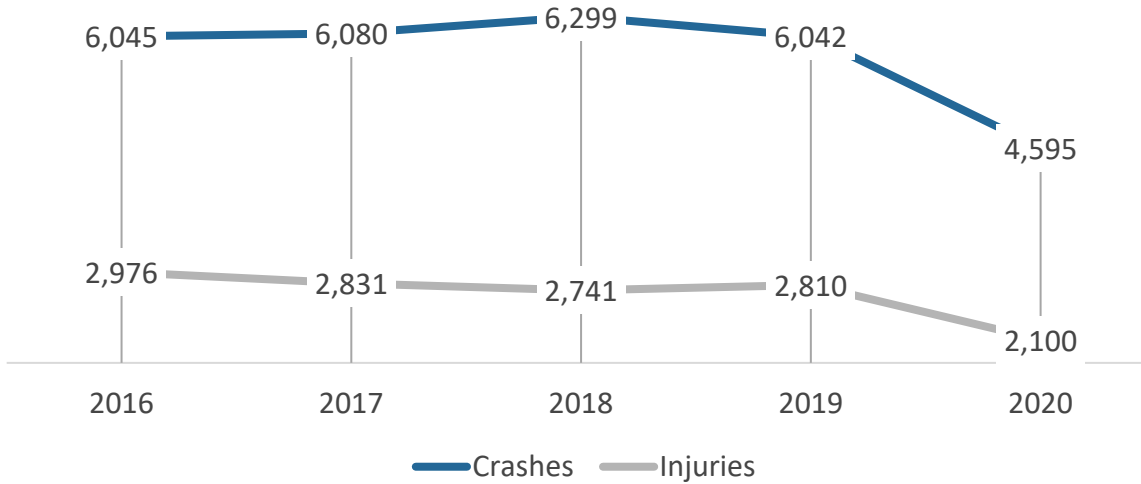

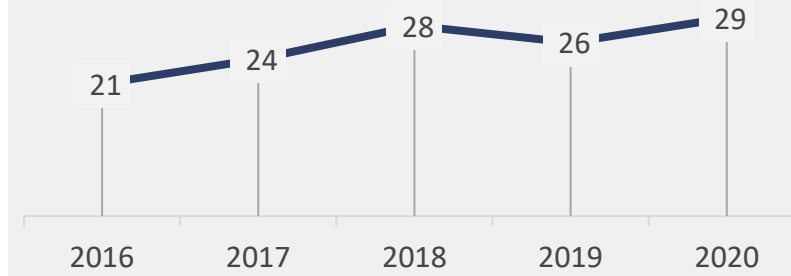

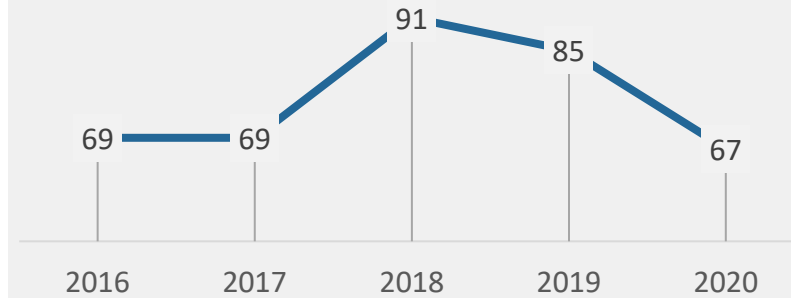
REPORTABLE TRAFFIC CRASHES AND INJURIES, 2016-2020



TRAFFIC FATALITIES, 2016-2020

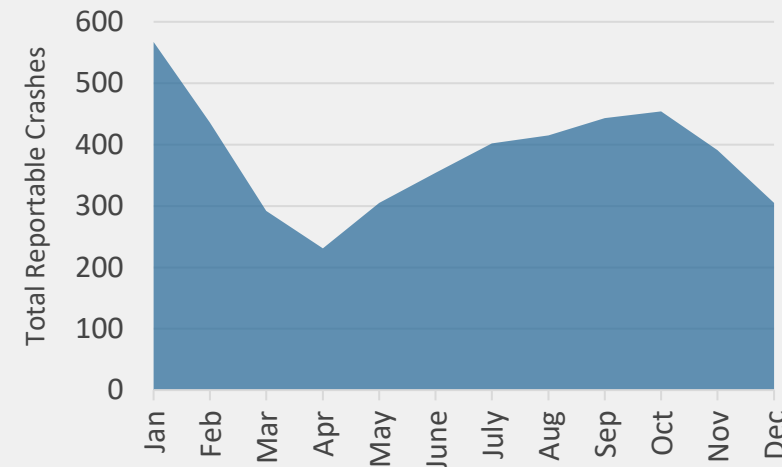

2020 TRAFFIC CRASHES BY MONTH

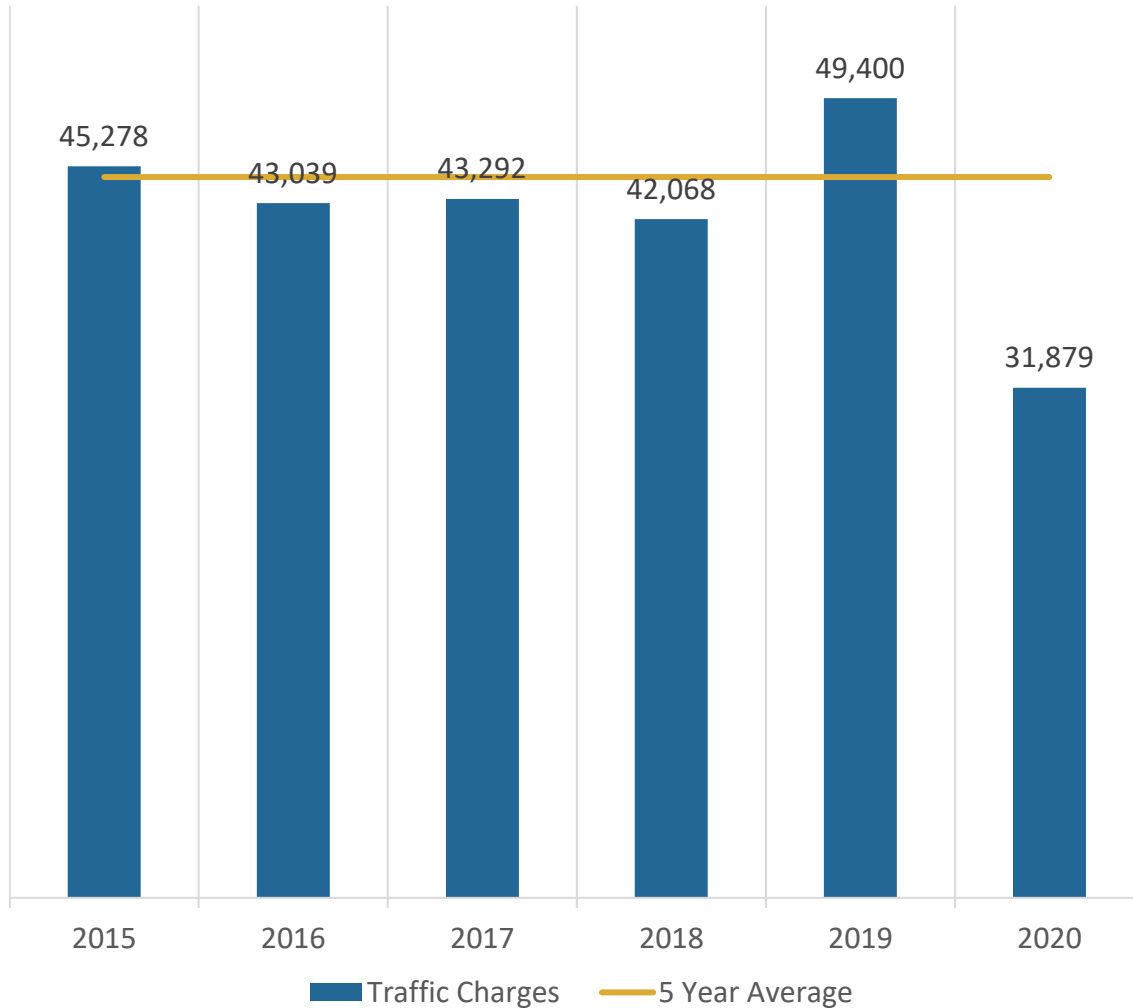

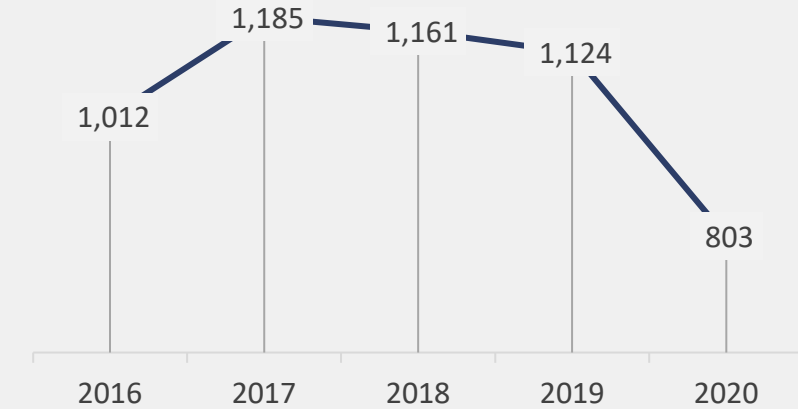


# TRAFFIC CHARGES AND ARRESTS

## COVID-19 | TRAFFIC CHARGES & ARRESTS

After a global pandemic was declared in March 2020, daily activities across Virginia were significantly altered. Schools, businesses and restaurants were closed. Events were cancelled. Telework increased. Stay at home orders were issued. Accordingly, traffic on our roadways decreased.

In 2020, there was a 29% decrease in DUI Arrests from 2019, and a 27% decrease from the five-year average.

In 2020, there was a 35% decrease in traffic-related charges from to 2019, and a 29% decrease from the five-year average.
