



Hotel / Motel Safety Tips for Guests

- Never leave unattended computer equipment in your room.
- Be alert and aware of strangers who follow you to your room.
- Report all suspicious persons to management and to the police.
- When occupying your room, use all locking devices on doors and windows.
- Always verify who is at your door.
- Never open your door to a stranger.
 - * Call the front desk and ask for management assistance or police.
- Keep valuables in a hotel safe or in your room safe if one is available.
- Do not display room keys in public places or where they could be lost or stolen.
- Park your vehicle in well-lit areas.
- Do not keep valuables in your vehicle. If you must put valuables in your vehicle, lock them in the trunk.
- Carry only as much cash as you need.
- When using traveler's checks or credit cards, keep them in a safe place. Have the appropriate numbers in case of loss or theft.
