



## Neighborhood Parking Violations

Henrico Municipal Code contains laws regarding parked vehicles. These laws are in place for the safety of the public. An important one that may impact your neighborhood is Section 22-153, which notes many violations, several of which are listed below:

- Parking or stopping on the wrong side of the street.
- Blocking a driveway.
- Parking within 15 feet of an intersection.
- Parking within 15 feet of a fire hydrant.
- Parking away from the curb.



Violation of any of these codes may cause you to be issued a citation. Please remember to park your vehicle in the safest possible manner and follow the laws of Henrico County.
