Welcome to the County of Henrico citizen information meeting on the proposed Pump Road Sidewalk Improvements Project. The purpose of this meeting is to provide an opportunity for citizens or organizations to give comments on the proposed project. The County wants all members of the community to have the opportunity to participate in public involvement on projects affecting them.

Project Description

This project will construct a 5-foot wide concrete sidewalk with a 2-foot wide grass utility strip along the east side of Pump Road connecting the sidewalk that currently ends just north of Sandy Bluff Drive to the existing sidewalk just south of Hazel Tree Drive (approximately 0.45 mile). The project will include roadway widening, curb and gutter, and drainage improvements.
