To better assist you with using this guide, we have developed the following list of questions to help you better understand what services or resources might best meet your needs.

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

We serve people experiencing the effects of or are at risk for mental illness, intellectual disability, and substance abuse, as well as children with developmental delay. Henrico Area Mental Health and Developmental Services promotes dignity, recovery and self-sufficiency in the lives of the people we serve.

### **Mental Health Services**

Many mental health problems experienced by adults are in response to family crises, unusually high stress or traumatic events. Brief adult services provide a variety of therapeutic services for adults experiencing severe psychological and/or interpersonal difficulties. Services are provided in individual and group therapy format. Since interpersonal relationship problems are frequently present, spouses and other family members may also be involved in treatment.

### **Other Services**

Henrico Area Mental Health and Developmental Services provides a variety of services and resources such as Adult Mental Health Recovery Services, Adult Substance Abuse Services, Dialectical Behavioral Therapy, Outpatient Services, Women's Services, Opiate Services, and Detoxification and Residential Treatment. ### **Fees**

Fees are based on the cost of delivering each service. A sliding scale, based on family income and number of dependents, allows the agency to make payment adjustments. Fees may be covered by Medicaid, Medicare or other third-party insurance. No one is denied service due to an inability to pay. Henrico Area Mental Health and Developmental Services does not discriminate based on sex, age, religion, race, handicap or national origin.

# Henrico Department of Community Revitalization

The Department of Community Revitalization was created in 2004 to coordinate the County's revitalization programs and services intended to promote healthy, vibrant and attractive residential, commercial and industrial communities.

### **Homeowner Rehabilitation and Repair Assistance**

Henrico County has two programs that assist current homeowners with improvements to their homes with both minor and emergency repairs and moderate rehabilitation. These programs are available to qualifying low- and moderate-income homeowners. The Emergency and Minor Housing Repair Program provides for the repair or replacement of exterior or interior items that pose an imminent threat to the health and/or safety of the residents. The cost of repairs can go up to \$10,000.

The Moderate Rehabilitation Housing Rehabilitation Program enhances the long-term livability of homes by undertaking substantial home improvements addressing health and safety issues, as well as complete system upgrades, energy efficiency and adaptability improvements. Improvements up to \$45,000 are available. All improvements bring the homes up to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Uniform Property Condition Standards. To be eligible for this program, homeowners must be elderly (62 or over) or disabled and must be of low or moderate income.

For both programs, all work is done by licensed contractors and overseen by professional rehabilitation specialists. Both programs are administered for the County by project:HOMES. ### **Real Estate Advantage Program (REAP)**

Pursuant to the Henrico County Code, persons qualifying for exemption are deemed to be bearing an extraordinary real estate tax burden in relation to their income and financial worth. The Real Estate Advantage Program (REAP) is a tax exemption for qualified seniors, residents that are 100 percent permanently and totally disabled, and their spouses, which relieves real estate tax up to a maximum of \$3,000.

- Maximum total income is \$75,000
- Maximum total net worth allowed is \$500,000
- Maximum exemption awarded is \$3,200
- Filing deadline is April 1

The initial REAP application **and** certification forms must be completed and submitted to the Revenue Division for the qualifying year by April 1. Hardship cases will be considered through Dec. 31.

### **Documentation Needed**

Whether you are applying at your local government center in-person or mailing an application, supporting documentation for each entry of income and net worth <u>must</u> be included with all applications. Such documents include photocopies of:

- End of the year statements of income (previous year)
- End of the year checking and savings account statements (previous year)
- End of the year statements showing values of stocks owned (previous year)
- First time applicants need a <u>copy</u> of their birth certificate or driver's license as proof of age
- Proof of disability is required for those under 65 years of age. A certification from the Social Security Administration, such as an awards letter, will suffice or a letter from the Railroad Retirement Board, Department of Veteran Affairs, or two signed affidavits from Virginia licensed doctors to the effect that such person is permanently and totally disabled.
- Affidavits for disability may be obtained from the Revenue Division offices.

The Department of Public Works is responsible for developing, improving and maintaining an efficient and safe transportation and drainage network for Henrico County. We strive to provide each resident with an informative and factual response to any inquiry in a timely manner.

### **Services Provided**

File a Standing Water Complaint

County residents are encouraged to contact the Department of Public Works Standing
Water Initiative if they are experiencing mosquito problems or if they have a standing
water complaint. A complimentary mosquito inspection will be conducted on residential
or commercial properties to help find the cause of mosquito annoyance. Standing water
complaints will be investigated to determine if the area in question is a potential
mosquito breeding site and who is responsible for the area.

### Mosquito Inspection

We offer mosquito inspections on residential and commercial properties. To request a
mosquito inspection, please fill out the form on the website and an inspector will
contact you. An inspector will then call you to discuss findings and provide you with a
checklist of potential or active breeding sites on your property.

Questions or concerns regarding pavement markings

- Citizens can report the following:
  - o Potholes
  - Spills, dumping or other illicit discharges (non-emergency)
  - Signs, sign posts or pavement markings needing maintenance
  - Installation of new signs or pavement markings

The Adult Services Unit provides information, referrals and assistance to disabled adults and those 60 and older so they can live as independently as possible in the least restrictive setting possible and maintain the right to self-determination.

### **Adult Protective Services**

Receives and investigates reports when an adult is being abused, neglected, exploited or is atrisk. Provides a variety of health, housing, social and legal services to stop the mistreatment and prevent further abuse. May legally intervene in emergency situations to protect adults who lack the capacity to consent to services. These services are also available to residents living in nursing homes, assisted living facilities and adult group homes. Anyone who suspects abuse, neglect or exploitation can make an anonymous report by calling the 24-hour toll-free hotline at 1-888-83-ADULT (1-888-832-3858) or 804-501-7346 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m.

### **Adult Services**

Links customers and their families to community resources and provides some direct services for those who are eligible.

### They include:

- Home screenings for those seeking Medicaid benefits for personal care in the home, adult day care or nursing home placement. (Long Term Care Screening Request)
- Auxiliary grants provide supplemental payments for individuals seeking admission to or living in licensed adult homes.
- Companion Program assists home-bound residents with their daily living activities.
- Annual Guardianship Reports are read for an incapacitated person. Staff can assist with filing the report.

### **Case Management**

Trained social workers can help customers and their families make decisions in times of crisis for support services. They also provide service referrals to community programs providing home-based care, transportation, adult day care, money management, nutrition services, placement services and other activities that assist eligible residents. A support group for grandparents who are raising grandchildren is held monthly. For a list of services, call 804-501-7346.

### Henrico County Community Emergency Response Team (HCCERT) Training

The purpose of HCCERT is to provide training to citizens to help cope immediately following a disaster when local public safety resources may be overwhelmed. HCCERT members learn basic first aid, search and rescue, and fire suppression techniques. But more importantly, HCCERT members learn how to PREPARE for a disaster long before one occurs. By being prepared and knowing how to respond to a situation, a HCCERT member, their family, friends and co-workers will be able to cope with the stresses of a disaster.

### If you are being hurt and feel that you are in immediate danger, call 9-1-1!

If you would like to speak to the Domestic Violence Coordinator, call 804-501-5732. If no one answers, leave a message and the Domestic Violence Coordinator will return your call. You may also email the Domestic Violence Coordinator at domestic\_violence@henricopolice.org. Domestic violence is a pattern of behaviors used by one person in a relationship to control the other. Behaviors may include emotional, financial or psychological abuse.

### Other examples of domestic violence include:

- Name calling or putdowns
- Stalking
- Preventing a partner from contacting family or friends
- Withholding money
- Actual or threatened physical harm
- Actual or threatened sexual harm
- Preventing a partner from getting or keeping a job

### Certain forms of abuse may be criminal such as domestic assault, sexual assault or stalking.

**Domestic assault** is a sudden, violent attack that may involve grabbing, pushing, kicking, hitting or threatening physical harm to a spouse, boyfriend or girlfriend, child, or other family or household member. **Sexual assault** is an unlawful physical attack upon another person, pertaining to or for sex, with or without battery, but may include sexually abusing a person against that person's will, with the use of force, threat or intimidation. **Stalking** is to pursue or proceed in a steady, deliberate or sinister manner, placing a person in fear of sexual assault, bodily injury or death with repeated actions that may include following someone, sending numerous emails or texts, calling repeatedly or sending unwanted gifts or letters.

### Anyone can be a victim.

Victims can be of any age, race, culture, education, sex, religion, employment or relationship status. Children and pets in homes where abuse exists are more likely to be abused and/or neglected. Even if children are not physically harmed, they may have emotional and behavioral problems.

# Henrico County Project Lifesaver

Project Lifesaver is a rapid response program that aids victims and families who suffer from Alzheimer's disease, dementia or autism. The program uses state of the art technology and specially trained officers to locate individuals who have wandered away.



The patient wears a personalized bracelet that emits a tracking signal, allowing the officers to locate the patient quickly. The average rescue time is 22 minutes after the individual has been reported missing. Project Lifesaver has been a very successful program for the Sheriff's Office because no deaths or serious injuries have been reported once the specially trained officers have located the individual.

There are approximately 150,000 individuals aged 65 and older in Virginia with Alzheimer's disease, making Project Lifesaver an important and helpful program.

Project Lifesaver is funded through charitable donations from generous organizations and individuals.

# The Virginia Insurance Counseling and Assistance Program (VICAP)

The Virginia Insurance Counseling and Assistance Program (VICAP) is a free, non-biased and confidential health insurance counseling service for Medicare beneficiaries and/or caregivers of people with Medicare. VICAP is part of a nationwide network of health insurance programs. Locally, VICAP is sponsored by Senior Connections, The Capital Area Agency on Aging.

Trained volunteer counselors provide counseling on Medicare and other health insurance benefits through interaction by phone or in-person. VICAP counselors do not make decisions for clients but instead help people review options and make informed and personalized choices on health insurance coverage.

VICAP counselors provide information on:

- Medicare (for seniors and the disabled under 65 with Medicare)
- Medicare Supplemental Insurance (Medigap)
- Medicare Advantage
- Medicare Prescription Drug Plan (Part D)
- Extra help for Part D costs
- Long Term Care Insurance
- Medicare Savings Programs for help with Medicare premiums, deductibles, and copayments
- Understanding medical and insurance statements
- Filing claims and appeals
- Medicare and Medicaid Fraud and Abuse

# **Long Term Care Ombudsman Program**

The mission of Senior Connections, The Capital Area Agency on Aging's Long-Term Care Ombudsman Program is to act as an advocate for older persons receiving long-term care, whether the care is provided in a nursing home or assisted living facility, or through community-based services to assist persons still living at home. Ombudsman services are free and confidential. If consumers of long-term care services are unable to resolve problems on their own, the Ombudsman will assist them to find a solution.

The objectives of the Ombudsman Program are:

- Receive, investigate and work to resolve complaints involving quality of care in a confidential manner
- Assist residents in exercising their rights
- Mediate concerns between residents (and/or their families) and the facility/provider
- Provide residents and their families with information about long term care resources in our community

Long-Term Care Ombudsmen assist residents of Long-Term Care facilities and their families by providing the following services:

- Promotes the civil and human rights of long-term care residents
- Assists residents to obtain needed services
- Empowers residents and families to advocate for themselves
- Consults with residents, families, and facilities to avoid problems, or solve them before they become crises
- Educates consumers and the community about long-term care issues, provides technical assistance to providers, and promotes increased community involvement in long-term care facilities
- Investigates and attempts to resolve concerns and complaints made by, or on behalf of, long-term care residents including suspicions of abuse and neglect
- Works with resident and family councils, community organizations, and state and federal enforcement agencies to improve residents' quality of life
- Seeks a regular presence in all long-term care facilities to identify problem areas and advocate for change
- Coordinates efforts with other agencies and service providers
