

# Spiderman Web Craft

**Time Required:** 20 minutes

**Prep Required:** None

**Space(s) Needed:** Indoor

**Materials:**

- Hula Hoop
- 1-2" wide masking tape
- Cotton balls

## Instructions:

**Step 1.** Make a line of masking tape down the middle of the Hula hoop. Make sure all sticky sides of the tape are facing the same way.

**Step 2.** Make a 2<sup>nd</sup> line of masking tape across the middle of the Hula hoop making an X. Do this two more times to create 8 equal pie shaped sections.

**Step 3.** Use masking tape to make two or three web circles of tape gradually getting smaller 'til you reach the center of the hula hoop circle.

**Step 4.** Use cotton balls to see how sticky Spiderman's web can be.

## Variations:

- Find out who can throw and stick the most cotton balls to the web.
- Hang your spider man web on the wall as a bulletin board and use it to display pictures of your favorite superhero.
