

# SUPERHERO HOPSCOTCH

## Equipment

Chalk

Flat stone (or something similar like a small bean bag, button, or seashell)

## Directions

**Step 1:** Draw a hopscotch design on the ground. Chalk is the best drawing medium on asphalt, patio stones or concrete. The squares should be large enough to fit one foot and to make sure that a stone thrown into the square will not bounce out too easily.

**Step 2:** Throw a flat stone or similar object (small beanbag, shell, button, plastic toy) to land on square one. It has to land inside the square without touching the border or bouncing out. If you don't get it within the lines, you lose your turn and pass the stone to the next person. If you do get it, however, go on to the next step.

**Step 3:** Hop through the squares, skipping the one you have your marker on. Each square gets one foot. You can't have more than one foot on the ground at a time, *unless* there are two number squares right next to each other. In that case, you can put down both feet simultaneously (one in each square).

**Step 4:** Pick up the marker on your way back. When you get to the last number, turn around (remaining on one foot) and hop your way back in reverse order. While you're on the square right before the one with your marker, lean down (probably on one foot still!) and pick it up. Then, skip over that square and finish up.

**Step 5:** Pass the marker on to the next person.

## Variation

Change the shape of the hopscotch course.
