

Tissue Paper Butterflies

Time Required: 30 minutes

Prep Required: None

Space (s) Needed: Indoors

Materials:

Pipe cleaners

Tissue paper

Googly eyes

Markers

Glue

Scissors

Crayons

Instructions:

1. Pick six pieces of tissue paper. Cut three into a large square, a medium square, and a small square. Then cut three into a large oval, a medium oval, and a small oval.
2. Bunch the sections together.
3. The square bunch is the top part of the butterfly body and the oval is the bottom half.
4. Fold the pipe cleaner over the butterfly body and twist it to secure the two pieces.
5. Cut the edges of the butterfly wings to add more shape.

Variations:

- If cutting the different sized/ shaped layers is too difficult-Use one sheet of paper and fold it accordion style, cut the ends and fasten it with a pipe cleaner. Spread each side the form wings.
