**Free Document Shredding**

**Document Shredding Information**

- Personal documents for shredding are accepted at no cost. Please place these items in paper grocery bags or boxes ONLY.
- All other containers will be handed back to the citizen.
- Each citizen is limited to two full boxes (10"x13"x18") OR three full paper grocery bags.
- Please remove - all paperclips, binder clips, 3-ring binders, bound books, metal spirals in notebooks, file folders, plastic sleeves, etc. Personal documents only!

**Free\* Electronics Recycling**

**Electronics Recycling Information**

Electronics that are accepted free of charge:

- Monitors
- Computers
- Printers
- Computer Peripherals
- Audio/Video Equipment
- VCRs
- DVD Players
- Video Cameras
- Phones
- Pagers
- Copy Machines
- Wireless Devices
- Video Game Consoles
- Kitchen Appliances

**\*Costs for certain electronics:**

- CRT TVs, 27 inches or less: \$25
- CRT TVs, 28 inches or more: \$35
- LCD TVs, 46 inches or less: \$20
- LCD TVs, 47 inches or more: \$30
- Projection TVs: \$30

**Items that are NOT accepted:**

- Compact fluorescent light bulbs, refrigerators, dehumidifiers, AC units, and other items such as clothing or batteries that are not considered an electronic.

**NOTE:** Do not place electronic items in the bags or boxes with your shredding items. This will jam the machines. Electronics recycling is separate from the document shredding.

## Shred It to Protect It Event

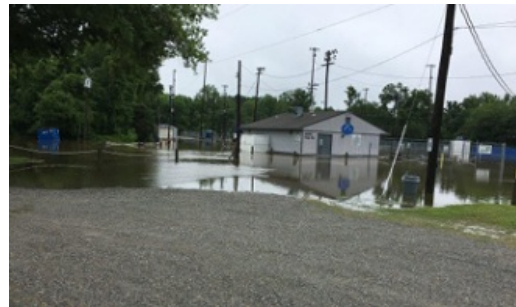
