MONUMENT DESCRIPTION:

36" concrete monument with 3.25" bronze cap. Stamped 142 1998, located just East of Tuckahoe Creek on the North side of U.S. Route 250. The monument is set on the county line between Henrico and Goochland, 24.5' ± North of the face of curb, 16.8' East of power pole #VP LM61, 9640 A and located N 16° 54' 10" E 210.75' from Mon #132. The county line between Henrico and Goochland is on a bearing of N 15° 36' 52" E (grid). Mon #142 was set by the Henrico Department of Public Works on 7-26-99 by traditional survey techniques. The County Surveyor in charge of this work was David Holland, LS. Control used to establish this monument = Mon #132 & Mon #139.
