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## Summary of Actions Taken by the Board on February 8, 2000

The invocation was given by Dr. Fred Rose, Pastor, Tuckahoe Presbyterian Church.

### MANAGER'S COMMENTS

The National Juvenile Detention Association once again sponsored the "Bob Rader Line Staff Worker of the Year" award and the "Bob Rader Detention Services Worker of the Year" award.
