# Summary of Actions Taken by the Board on August 14, 2001

The invocation was given by Reverend David Wruck, Associate Pastor, Victory Baptist Church.

The minutes of the July 24, 2001 Regular and Special Meetings, May 30, 2001 Special Meeting, and March 19 - 22, 2001 Special Meeting were approved.

#### **MANAGER'S COMMENTS**

On November 21, 2000, Jail East was inspected by the Virginia Department of Corrections (DOC) and received a 100% compliance rating. On July 27, 2001, the DOC completed a two-day unannounced inspection of Jail West and advised Sheriff Michael L. Wade that this facility was also 100% in compliance. Maj. Douglas A. Herbert is the Administrator of Jail East, Maj. Carlos V. Talley is the Administrator of Jail West, and Lt. Darlean H. Dailey oversees Jail Standards for the Henrico Sheriff's Office.

Karen M. Adams, who has served as an Assistant County Attorney for Henrico since February 1989, was recently elected President of the 270-member Henrico Bar Association at the organization and sannual banquet. Mrs. Adams is the fourth person from the County Attorney S Office to have held this position.

On August 1, 2001, Mr. Hazelett welcomed the arrival of Ronald L. Mastin as Henrico County's new Fire Chief. Chief Mastin was previously employed by Fairfax County, where he served as Deputy Chief for the Operations Division. He has 28 years of fire service experience and holds a Bachelor's degree in Fire Administration and Management from the University of Maryland.

The articles addressed the impact of the multi-state Chesapeake Bay 2000 Watershed Partnership Agreement on Virginia local governments. She advised that Mr. Perry and Mr. White were also assisting her with an article on the County's new watershed management program for publication in a future issue of *Virginia Review* magazine.

Mrs. O'Bannon noted that Ross Lawrence, the son of Clerk to the Board Barry Lawrence, was in the audience observing the meeting.

Mr. Glover announced that the 10-Year-Old Glen Allen Babe Ruth All-Star Team won the inaugural baseball World Series for their age level in Vincennes, Indiana on August 10, 2001 with a 12-2 victory over Meridian, Mississippi in the Series final. Glen Allen went undefeated in 15 games of district, state, regional, and World Series Babe Ruth League (Cal Ripken Division) competition and outscored the opposition 190-24 while earning 224 hits and a .531 batting average. In becoming the first team from Virginia at any age level to win a World Series, Glen Allen placed three players on the World Series All-Tournament Team and provided the World Series Most Valuable Player (MVP).
