# Summary of Actions Taken by the Board on April 24, 2007

Mr. Donati led the Board, staff, and public in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

Rev. Charles Swadley, Pastor, Lakeside United Methodist Church, provided the invocation.

The Board approved the minutes of the April 10, 2007 Regular Meeting.

#### **BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' COMMENTS**

Mrs. O'Bannon recognized William Shimer from Boy Scout Troop 770, sponsored by River Road Presbyterian Church, who was observing the meeting to fulfill a requirement for the Citizenship in the Community Merit Badge.

Mr. Glover reiterated concerns he expressed at the April 10, 2007 Board meeting by questioning the Governor's recent action to overturn the General Assembly's approval of an \$11 to \$22 million per year increase in State funding to the County for road maintenance, an amount equaling five to ten cents on the County's real estate tax rate. He asked for an explanation from the Governor on this matter and commented that Henrico citizens are not receiving their fair share of gasoline tax revenues from the State.
