BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' COMMENTS

Mr. Nelson noted that several County agencies came together over the course of 11 days in late August to renovate and spruce up the exterior grounds of Highland Springs High School. He offered a special thanks to Sheriff Mike Wade for providing eight inmates who worked 587 hours and two staff members who worked 320 hours, which saved the County \$13,605 in painting costs.
