#### **PUBLIC HEARING ITEMS**

RESOLUTION – Authorizing the County Manager to Submit the Henrico County Five-Year Consolidated Plan and the Annual Action Plan, including the CDBG, HOME, and ESG Program Plans for Fiscal Year 2015-16; to Execute the CDBG, HOME, and ESG Agreements for Fiscal Year 2015-16; and to Execute Contracts to Implement the CDBG, HOME, and ESG Activities.

This resolution authorizes the County Manager to submit the Henrico County Five-Year Consolidated Plan and the Annual Action Plan consisting of the CDBG, HOME, and ESG Fiscal Year 2015-16 Plans to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) by August 15, 2015 in accordance with federal submission requirements. It also authorizes the County Manager to execute agreements with HUD for Fiscal Year 2015-16 for the Henrico CDBG, HOME, and ESG programs. Finally, it authorizes the County Manager to execute contracts in a form approved by the County Attorney to implement the Fiscal Year 2015-16 CDBG, HOME, and ESG activities.

The County's entitlements for 2015-16 are: CDBG, \$1,575,820; HOME, \$599,842; and ESG, \$139,425.

The Department of Community Revitalization has prepared the attached table of the proposed sources and uses of these funds. The proposed use of funds includes \$63,000 in HOME funds unspent from previous years.

The Director of Community Revitalization recommends approval, and the County Manager concurs.

## RESOLUTION - Amendments to the FY 2014-15 Annual Fiscal Plan: June, 2015.

A Board paper was presented on June 9, 2015, which (a) received requests for amendments to the Annual Fiscal Plan, (b) directed the advertisement of same, and (c) set the date for a public hearing. The Board may now receive this paper, which, if approved, amends the Annual Fiscal Plan and appropriates funds for expenditure, as applicable, on June 23, 2015. After the public hearing, at that same meeting, this paper may be approved.

### **RESOLUTION – Appropriation of Funds for Fiscal Year 2015-16.**

This Board paper appropriates funds for the operating and capital Annual Fiscal Plans for fiscal year 2015-16 approved by the Board of Supervisors on April 28, 2015.

This Board paper also reappropriates to fiscal year 2015-16 (i) funds for ongoing capital projects, (ii) funds budgeted in fiscal year 2014-15 for the long-term disability benefit, (iii) funds for all valid outstanding encumbrances as of June 30, 2015, and (iv) funds for grant programs and donations, for specific purposes that extend beyond June 30, 2015, and all unspent asset forfeiture funds, all within the Special Revenue Fund. These funds are reappropriated to the same department and account for which they are originally appropriated or encumbered.

# RESOLUTION - Award of Construction Contract - Dartmouth Avenue & Horsepen Road Area (Phase 2) Water Rehabilitation - Tuckahoe District.

This Board paper awards a construction contract to C.T. Purcell, Inc. to replace approximately 1.3 miles of water piping in the Dartmouth Avenue and Horsepen Road area for \$1,498,884.

The project will maintain the reliability of the water system by replacing deteriorated water piping installed in the late 1940s and 1950s. The work will begin in July 2015 and will be completed by September 2016. Funding for the contract will be provided by the Water and Sewer Revenue Fund.

Four bids were received on April 16, 2015, in response to IFB #15-9723-1CE and Addendum No. 1:

Based upon a review of the bids, C.T. Purcell, Inc. is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

This Board paper awards the contract to C.T. Purcell, Inc. and grants signatory authority to the County Manager to execute the contract in a form approved by the County Attorney. The County Manager, or the Purchasing Director as his designee, is authorized to execute change orders within the scope of the project budget not to exceed 15% of the original contract amount.

The Director of Public Utilities and the Purchasing Director recommend approval of this Board paper, and the County Manager concurs.
