PROCLAMATION - Fire Prevention Week - October 4 - 10, 2015.

The 2015 Fire Prevention Week theme, "Hear the Beep Where You Sleep: Every Bedroom Needs a Working Smoke Alarm!" effectively serves to remind us that we need working smoke alarms to get out safely. This proclamation recognizes October 4 - 10, 2015, as Fire Prevention Week and calls the observance to the attention of all Henrico citizens.

PROCLAMATION - Customer Service Week - October 5 - 9, 2015.

The County of Henrico continues to be recognized locally, nationally, and internationally for the quality of service it provides to all of its customers. PUBLIC HEARINGS ITEMS

RESOLUTION – Amendments to the FY 2015-16 Annual Fiscal Plan: September, 2015.

A Board paper was presented on September 8, 2015, which (a) received requests for amendments to the Annual Fiscal Plan, (b) directed their advertisement, and (c) set the date for a public hearing. The Board may now receive this paper, which, if approved, amends the Annual Fiscal Plan and appropriates funds for expenditure, as applicable, on September 22, 2015. After the public hearing, at that same meeting, this paper may be approved.

RESOLUTION - Signatory Authority - Easement Agreements - Virginia Electric and Power Company and Colonial Pipeline Company - Cumberland County.

This resolution authorizes the Chairman of the Board of Supervisors to execute easement agreements with Virginia Electric and Power Company and Colonial Pipeline Company allowing them to relocate their facilities for the Cobbs Creek Reservoir Project. The County Attorney will approve the form of the easement agreements.

INTRODUCTION OF ORDINANCE - To Amend and Reordain Section 20-78 of the Code of the County of Henrico Titled "Elderly or Permanently and Totally Disabled Persons" to Increase the Maximum Annual Real Estate Tax Exemption for Qualified Real Estate Advantage Program Applicants From \$2,500 to \$3,000.

This Board paper introduces for advertisement and public hearing on October 13 an ordinance to increase the maximum annual real estate tax exemption for qualified REAP applicants from \$2,500 to \$3,000.

RESOLUTION - Concurring in the Declarations and Findings of the Reynolds Crossing Community Development Authority and Authorizing the Dissolution of such Authority and the Execution of Documents in Connection Therewith.

The purpose of this Board paper is to authorize the dissolution of the Reynolds Crossing Community Development Authority. The County has received a certified copy of a resolution adopted by the board of the Authority on July 29, 2015, indicating that the Authority's bonds have been paid and requesting that the Authority be dissolved.

After the Board of Supervisors authorizes the dissolution, the County Attorney will file Articles of Dissolution and Articles of Termination of Corporate Existence with the State Corporation Commission.

This paper will be discussed with the Board in a work session on September 22, 2015.

RESOLUTION - Signatory Authority - Acquisition of Real Property - 801 East Williamsburg Road and 200 Whiteside Drive - Varina District.

The Board Paper authorizes the County Manager to execute documents to purchase $99.234\pm$ acres with improvements at 801 East Williamsburg Road and 200 Whiteside Drive in the Varina District for \$2,800,000, for future recreational purposes. The sellers desire to have the portion of the property used for park purposes designated as the "Colonel Samuel Gatewood Taylor, Jr. Park" to be commonly called "Taylor Park".

The Directors of Recreation and Parks and Real Property recommend approval of this Board paper, and the County Manager concurs.

RESOLUTION - Acceptance of Roads - Three Chopt District.

This Board paper would accept the following named and described sections of roads into the County road system for maintenance.

1) 0.64 miles of Dalton Park at Sadler Walk, Section 1 and a Resubdivision of the Area Reserved for Future Development of Crawford Park at Greenbrooke, Section A, and Lots 19 through 23 and a Portion of Lots 24, 25 and 26 of McDonald's Small Farms – Three Chopt District.

The Director of Public Works recommends approval of this Board paper, and the County Manager concurs.
