COUNTY OF HENRICO, VIRGINIA BOARD OF SUPERVISORS SPECIAL MEETING February 8, 2022

Update on the Addiction Treatment Initiation Center

Laura Totty, Director of Mental Health and Developmental Services, gave the Board a brief update on what would be called a Treatment Initiation Center to provide medical stabilization and help patients begin treatment and recovery. Mr. Nelson questioned why the center was not being called a detox center as originally planned. Mrs. Totty explained the desire is to not have individuals just come to the facility to detox but also begin the process of recovery. Mr. Nelson expressed the desire that the community knows it will be a detox center.

Dr. James Thompson, Founder and Chief Medical Officer at the Master Center for Addiction explained the benefit of naming the facility a treatment initiation center, and Mr. Vithoulkas clarified that the Master Center is the County's consultant and not a potential offeror of operator services. Mr. Vithoulkas will provide more information to the Board, and Mr. Branin requested individual meetings to discuss the plans.

2022 Bond Referendum Update

Brandon Hinton, Deputy County Manager for Administration, updated the Board about plans for the 2022 Bond Referendum. Mr. Hinton will lead the community education effort with six teams as the County did with the meals tax referendum. Mr. Vithoulkas praised Dr. Danny Avula, Director of Health, and John Neal, Director of General Services, who are leaving their positions after dedicated service to the County.

Mr. Vithoulkas briefly reviewed the agenda items for the 7:00 p.m. meeting.
