Energy Management Update

Carrie Webster, Energy Manager, described the County's efforts to track energy use, conserve energy, and increase the use of renewable energy. There are current projects at the Eastern and Western Government Centers and solar projects at the Libbie Mill Library, Mental Health East Center, Public Safety Building, and various schools.

Update on Fall Line Trail Project

Todd Eure, Assistant Director of Public Works, discussed plans for the Fall Line Trail Project consisting of 43 miles of pedestrian and bike trails through Petersburg, Colonial Heights, the City of Richmond, Ashland, Chesterfield, Hanover, and Henrico. The project is being financed by grant and local funding, CVTA funding, and funding from the Commonwealth Transportation Board. The County is hoping for project completion by Fall 2025.

Finance Items

Sheila Minor, Director of Finance, reviewed the Finance items on the evening agenda, including an appropriation for 10 police officer positions, an allocation for the Greater Richmond Convention Center Authority, and the real estate property tax relief credit. She also discussed the necessary actions for a 2022 Bond Referendum.
