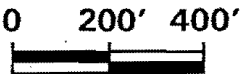


Gentlemen:

The Board of Supervisors at its meeting on February 10, granted your request for a revocable Provisional Use Permit in order to extend hours of operation until 2:00 a.m. daily for a billiard parlor (The Breakers) located at 4032-A Cox Road, Lakepointe Shopping Center, Part of Parcel 78-A2-9, Innsbrook, Section J, subject to the following conditions:

1. In the event that evidence (e.g. police calls to the premises, complaints from other businesses in the surrounding area, etc.) is adequate to indicate that the extended hours of operation, as requested, is having an adverse affect (i.e. increased public nuisance: loitering, noise outside of the building, criminal assaults, traffic, etc.) on the surrounding area, steps will be taken to revoke this permit.

The Planning Office has been advised of the action of the Board of Supervisors and requested to revise its records and to place a copy of this notification in the Provisional Use Permit Index.
