The Board of Supervisors at its meeting on May 12, granted your request for a revocable Provisional Use Permit in order to operate an East Coast convenience store/gasoline station with hours of service to the general public up to twenty-four (24) hours per day, Parcels 86-A1-11 and 33, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Extended hours of operation shall not result in an increase in loitering, criminal assaults, traffic or public nuisance in the area surrounding the business.
- 2. A minimum of two (2) employees will be on duty at the site between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m.
