

Gentlamen:

The Board of Supervisors at its meeting on April 12, granted your request for a revocable Provisional Use Permit in order to establish and operate a billiard parlor, however, the Board denied your request to extend operating hours to 2:00 a.m. on part of Parcel 92-B1-11, Foundatin Square, Section A, Lot 1, Fountain Square Shopping Center, Major League Lanes, 8037 Shrader Road, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Customers shall be required by the management to leave the premises, including parking areas, immediately after the close of business.
- 2. The operation of the business shall not cause loitering, criminal assaults or public nuisance in the area surrounding the business.
- 3. Prior to the issuance of a certificate of use and occupancy, the applicant shall acknowledge in writing to the Chief of Police and the Director of Planning the use will be operated in accordance with the provisions of Sections 3-1, 3-2 and 3-3 of Chapter 3 of the County Code pertaining to attendance by minors.
- 4. Security officer shall be provided in the parking area after 10:00 p.m. on Friday, Saturday and Sunday night.

The Planning Office has been advised of the action of the Board of Supervisors and requested to revise its records and to place a copy of of this notification in the Provisional Use Permit Index.
