


Gentlemen:

The Board of Supervisors at its meeting on October 9, 1996, granted your request for a revocable Provisional Use Permit in order to permit outdoor dining for the Boston Market Restaurant, 9450 W. Broad Street, Part of Parcel 59-A-6L, subject to the following conditions:

- 1. Trash receptacles shall be provided and properly serviced to control, as mush as possible, outside litter generated by this request.
- 2. No outside, amplified live music performances shall be permitted.
- 3. Any outside speakers or sound system shall comply with the following standards:
 - a. Equipped with controls permitting full volume adjustment.
 - b. Inaudible 100 feet away from the source.
 - c. Used only when outdoor dining is permitted
- 4. The outside dining area shall be limited to 705 square feet as indicated in the Planning Office file P-24-96.

The Planning Office has been advised of the action of the Board of Supervisors and requested to revise its records and to place a copy of this notification in the Provisional Use Permit Index.
